Show Proof of English and Math Proficiency</b></p>	<p>Come to Continuing Education, located on the first floor of the College Center Building (near the main entrance of campus) or email <a href="mailto:conted@seattlecolleges.edu">conted@seattlecolleges.edu</a> to show:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. transcripts proving English and Math proficiency <b><i>OR</i></b></li> <li>2. Current professional license registered with the Washington State Department of Health <b><i>OR</i></b></li> <li>3. CASAS Exam score</li> </ol> <p><b><i>*You will need to pay a \$15 administrative fee as part of the review process</i></b></p> <p>The CASAS Exam is used to evaluate the students understanding of English and Math. You will need to take the Casas Proctor Exam Form to the cashier to pay a \$35.00 exam fee, get your form stamped paid and then go to the Testing Center where you will be given 2 hours to complete the exam. <p><b>3. Register for class</b></p>	<p>When you bring your proof of proficiency (test results, transcripts, or professional license) to Continuing Education you will be given instructions on how to register in person or online for the Adult Family Home Administration Class.</p>
