This is a list of some basic supplies to get started in this class. As the class proceeds a few additional supplies will be suggested. You are welcome to bring any additional art supplies of your own, but please bring these basic supplies to the first class. Some art supply stores are Dakota Art, Artists and Craftsman, Daniel Smith, Dick Blick Art Supplies.

Acrylic Paints: Some basic colors are - Phthalo Blue, Ultramarine Blue, White, Lemon Yellow, Orange, Cadmium Red, Green, Plus any others colors you may choose to bring. Please do NOT bring "Liquitex *BASIC* Colors" paints.

Canvas Board. 11" x 14" to start

Acrylic Brushes: #7 #8 and a flat brush

Two Containers for water

Paper Palette

Masking Tape

Paper Towels

Bring at least 6 different landscape photos that have good definition (no sunsets or sunrises) and/or photocopies (black and white or color) of Impressionist landscapes to the first class. Remember you will be working from them so no tiny photos please.
