SUPPLY LIST

Cost to the participant: \$25 - \$37 (Likely estimated cost range for student with some supplies on hand who purchases older edition of book.)

\$59 (Total estimated cost for student with no supplies on hand who purchases newest edition of text book.)

1. Two 4B drawing pencils - \$3.00
2. One non-permanent black felt-tip marker (Vis-à-Vis or other brand, fine point) - \$1.50
3. One permanent black felt-tip marker (fine point) - \$2.00
4. Two 1inch wide (bulldog) clips - \$1.50 for two
5. One roll masking tape - \$1.50
6. One pencil sharpener \$1.00
7. One eraser (pink pearl, white plastic, kneaded) \$1.00
8. One drawing pad (white paper, 11x14) \$7.50
9. One lightweight drawing board, approximately 15x18 (Can be improvised from a piece of foam board, Masonite or thick cardboard) \$10.00
10. One mirror with stand, approximately 5 inches in diameter (large enough to see whole face) \$5.50
11. Book – Drawing on the Right Side of the Brain, by Betty Edwards (4th edition, 2012, ISBN #978-58542-920-2) \$17.00; or (1999 edition, ISBN#087477-424-1) \$2

Note: The following three items will be provided in class. However if you wish to draw outside of class or think you may miss a class you may want to get these items:

12. Piece of 8x10" clear plastic (about 1/16th inch thick), or 8x10" piece of glass (tape the edges). (Clear Cut Plastics or Tap Plastics may sell the clear plastic sheet.) \$3.00
13. Viewfinders (two, 8x10" outside measurement), made from black paper – poster board or construction paper. (Instructions for cutting viewfinders can be found on pg. 14 of the textbook.) \$1.50
14. Graphite stick - #4 General's is a good brand, or other brand. \$3.00
