- Sewing machine in good working order, power cord, foot pedal, instruction manual, etc.
- Extension cord
- Walking foot
- ¼" foot (optional)
- Bobbins
- All-purpose thread in a coordinating or neutral color
- Quilting Needles, size 75/11 and 90/14
- Straight pins
- Seam ripper
- Small scissors or nippers
- Rotary cutter (45mm)
- Cutting mat (18" x 24" or larger)
- Acrylic ruler (6" x 24")
- Iron and board in good working order, preferably with steam (at home, one will be provided for class)

Fabric Requirements

- We'll be making the Sampler Quilt (p. 41) in the book listed above.
 - The fabric yardages used are listed there.
 - You can use the suggested colors or pick your own.
- We will talk about fabric and color selection in the first class. You can wait to make you fabric choices until after that, if you have questions.
