### **Supplies List for Oil Painting**

#### **Required Oil Paint Colors:**

If you can, avoid colors with the name "Hue", ie: Cobalt Hue, Alizarin Hue as they are made with less pigment and will not mix as true)

Alizarin Crimson  
Burnt Sienna or Terra Rosa  
Cadmium Red light  
Phthalocyanine (Phalo) Blue  
Ultramarine Blue  
Viridian Green,  
Titanium White, large size  
Yellow Ochre  
Cadmium Yellow Medium  
Cadmium Yellow Pale (or Lemon)

\*Optional:, Dioxanine Purple, Cadmium Orange or Cadmium Yellow Deep, Thalo Green

#### **Recommended Paint Brushes:**

At least one each: #4, 6, & 8" Flat. A mix of synthetic and bristle brushes is recommended.

*One larger brush, #10 or #12.*

Pre-stretched Canvas and/or Canvas Boards:

- (1) 11" x 14" (or larger) canvas board or pre-stretched canvas for first day of class (more will be needed throughout the duration of course.

Miscellaneous:

- (1) Palette knife (metal)
- (2) Large size paper palette pad (for paint mixing)
- (3) Liquin (painting medium)

\*You can buy paint at: University Book Store, Dakota Art, Daniel Smith, Aaron Brothers, or Utrecht Art Stores. Most stores will give you 10% discount if you tell them you are a student.
