Please **ALSO** bring with you to class:

- Wet/dry sandpaper - 2 sheets each grit: 220, 320, 400, 600 (dark gray ones used for metal finishing)
- Beeswax lump or candle end (tea light candle works fine)
- Clear safety glasses
- Dust mask - N95
- Small CHEAP paintbrush with natural bristles (roughly #4 size)
- Fine point tweezers (4"- 5" long is a good size)
- 3 small containers for solder chips - (ex: multi-day pill box, buddy cups, screw-together bead jars, etc.)
- Cotton apron
- 1-2 old small hand/dish towels
- Pencil
- Fine point "Sharpie" marker
- Scotch brand Magic Tape
- Scissors
- Notebook or sketchbook
- Reading glasses, if you need a little help to see clearly 8" from your nose.

Please wear cotton clothing and closed toed leather shoes as we work with hot metal.
