Coloraid: two sizes will work, but larger size is preferred. 4" x 6" is currently listed at \$68.00 on Coloraid website. 3" x 4.5" is currently listed at \$37.20. Would plan to order through Bookstore.

Other supply costs would run approximately \$15, depending on what students already have:

- 10 + sheets of 9" x 12" (or larger) stiff white paper for mounting studies – Poster Board or Bristol board or construction paper all can work
- 10-20 Plastic cover sheets (8.5 x 11") for preserving studies
- A couple large envelopes (new or used, 9x12 or larger) for carrying Coloraid
- A fresh glue stick
- Reasonably fresh rubber or paper cement jar
- Scissors and/or (optional) mat knife and cutting surface
- Pen, pencil, notebook
- Tweezers (optional)
